

RMT Choir Leader

The successful applicant will be capable and have experience of teaching larger vocal groups across Academic Years 6-13. They will have demonstrable experience working with choirs, and will be willing and able to take responsibility for the arrangement of repertoire. Whilst the choir's predominant focus will be contemporary music, the Choir Leader should be open to working across a range of musical styles and genres.

The Choir Leader will be available to run the choir after school one day a week within the Twickenham area (location/duration/day to be decided with the successful applicant). They must be willing to commit to working 30 weeks per year (10 weeks per academic term). The Choir Leader must also be available to commit to RMT events/concerts which involve the choir, and willing to seek additional performance opportunities for them.
